General Ticketing/Reservations for Garden Fair Access

Tickets are required to access The Garden Fair. They can be purchased on-line. The Gardens are capacity controlled. Should you have any additional questions, you can reach us by calling 905-468-1362 Extension 873103 or by emailing reservations@vintage-hotels.com

- The General Admission is \$12 plus tax and fees [The Monet Garden Fair Admittance only]
- Premium Admission is \$20 plus tax and fees [The Monet Garden Fair Admittance, including Patio Glass and one 5oz glass of Wine or Signature Drink or non-alcoholic option]
- Garden Fair Hours of Operation (kindly note that walk-ins are not guaranteed and will be permitted on a capacity basis. Admittance will close 30 minutes prior to the event end time)
 - Friday May 8th 12noon to 8pm
 - Saturday May 9th 10am to 6pm
 - Sunday May 10th 10am to 6pm
 - Monday May 11th 10am to 4pm
- Children 10 and under are free, when accompanied by an adult under the General/Premium Admission. Kindly note that some events are 19+

Garden Access Tickets are non-refundable. The event will run in all weather. Garden Speaker Series are included with your admission and seating available on a first come, first serve basis. Additional Fees and Advanced Reservations required for planned Workshops as space is limited. Website Event pages may be further updated to include the full schedule, workshop options and designated Speakers by Day.

Is the Garden Accessible?

Accessibility Parking is located and labelled in the lot located adjacent to the Garden at John/Regent Street and available on a first come, first serve basis. The Garden and Vendor Fair is a completely Outdoor event and overall accessible. Please note that some walking paths may not be suitable for a wheelchair. Washrooms within the Garden are accessible.

Other Information

- The Gardens will be closed to the public and hotel guests on May 6 & 7th, 2026 for set up
- The Gardens are a pet free/dog free zone. Service Dogs are permitted with documentation.
- Light Fare will be available for purchase within The Monet Garden.
- Both Alcoholic and non-alcoholic Beverages will be available for purchase within The Monet Gardens and at The OutPost.
- **No outside Food & Beverage will be permitted within The Gardens.**
- The Monet Garden is a smoke free/vape free environment.
- Bicycles are not permitted within The Monet Garden.
- Dress for the Weather. Please wear appropriate footwear for walking in The Gardens and on the Garden paths. High heel shoes are not recommended.
